THE 5 FIRST SATURDAYS DEVOTIONS TO THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

Beginning on 13th May 1917, Our Lady appeared each month for 6 months to 3 young shepherds (Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco) in Fatima, Portugal.

She told Lucia then that she would come back to tell her about spreading devotion to her Immaculate Heart and 1925, when Lucia was a nun in Pontevedra, Spain, Our Lady appeared to her again when she said, 'I promise to assist at the hour of death, with all the graces necessary for salvation, all those who, on the first Saturday of five consecutive months, go to Confession, receive Holy Communion, recite 5 decades of the Rosary with the intention of making Reparation to me.'

Many of our parishioners are already aware of and practise the Five First Saturday Devotions. As the 100th anniversary of the first apparition of Fatima is to be celebrated in May 2017, we propose as a parish to complete the Five First Saturday's in St Joseph's, Glenavy, starting Saturday 7th January 2017 and ending on Saturday 6th May 2017.

If you wish to come to a public recitation of the Rosary on those days, it begins at 9.30am; Mass is at 10.00am followed by a half hour of Adoration during which Confessions are available and time for 15 minutes meditation on the Rosary.

One hours devotion each Saturday for five Saturdays with the eternal reward attached to it.....don't miss this opportunity!
