#### LOVE IS NEVER LOST

The gospel is a story about people trying to do well and often not much comes from it. One mother said, 'I hope I'll see some of my children at the altar again before I die'. A football trainer said, I wish we won matches when he was in school – but the fruit of all the hours came later when he scored goals for the county!'

A big point of this story is about the fruits -30-, 60-, 100-fold. When we work at love or faith, the deeper things of life, something good happens.

We try to hand on faith in the family and school situations. Sometimes we feel we see little return for our work. Or we give time to the family in many ways and see little return for our love.

The consoling point of the story – we never know when or where there will be the fruits of our love ... Love given is never lost. Like dropping something into the river, you never know where it will end up. Love given to children in the family may bear fruit in the next generation. We never know. Good may be done in a son's or daughter's new country from the seeds of faith planted at home.

Part of life is trial and effort. Jesus' attitude was the same. He 'threw' out love like the sower throws out the seed. He knows it may fall on hard ground, but he gives it anyway. He gave love on Calvary to everyone. God is like that. It may take years to flower. God doesn't stint the seed, nor does he stint love.

On your inbreath, echo the word 'love'.

On the outbreath send this love to someone who may need it now.

May I live, Lord, in your love that never ends?

## SALE OF GRAVES IN ST JOSEPH'S GRAVEYARD

Requests for a right of burial (a grave), in St Joseph's Graveyard, are regularly received from individuals who are not resident in the parish.

A few years ago the graveyard at St Joseph's received a significant extension.

There is sufficient space to enable the Parish to offer for sale a limited number of burial rights. It has been decided therefore to invite applications from persons who are not currently resident but would wish to be buried at St Joseph's. Rights of burial will be restricted to persons who have a family connection with the parish.

The cost of these burial rights will reflect the fact that purchasers or their families are not and would not be expected to be contributing members of the parish and the fee therefore will be similar to that of a grave in the Diocesan Milltown Cemetery in Belfast. Each grave could receive up to three interments.

Application forms with all the details are available from the Parish Office should be returned as soon as possible but by  $1^{st}$  September 2017 at the latest.

Parishioners can be assured that there is ample space for all who are entitled to be buried in our graveyard.

**TROCÁTRE COLLECTION:** The Irish Catholic Bishops' Conference has announced that special collections at all Masses will take place across Ireland on the weekend of 22 and 23 July to fund lifesaving aid for people currently affected by the devastating hunger crisis in east-Africa. The money raised will be donated to Trócaire, the overseas development agency of the Catholic Church in Ireland, which is delivering emergency food, water and health care to the 25 million people affected.

Severe drought, driven by climate change, is currently affecting Kenya, South Sudan, Somalia and Ethiopia and this has resulted in failed harvests and the widespread death of livestock. Conflict has exacerbated the effects in South Sudan and Somalia, with areas in both countries now on the verge of famine

Trócaire have been providing emergency food aid, water and healthcare to affected communities - quite literally life-support for affected people. Trócaire's health centres in Somalia are treating approximately 19,000 people each month for malnutrition and associated illnesses. With the support of parishioners here at home in the coming weeks, many tens of thousands more people will receive help. For example, over 13,000 children in Kenya will receive supplementary high-energy food, new boreholes will be provided for communities, many more people will receive monthly food rations and schools will be supplied with water
