# THE SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION Tuesday 15 August Holy Day of Obligation.

Masses are as follows

**Mater Dei:** Monday 14th vigil Mass 7.00pm and Tuesday 15th 9.30am

**St Joseph's:** Tuesday 15th 9.30am

<u>Rosary Procession</u> Tuesday 15th August St Joseph's Church after 9.30 Mass. All 1st Communicants in their outfits are invited to lead all the children of the parish to the adjoining Grotto. Refreshments afterwards

**The Solemnity of the Assumption** of Our Lady celebrates Mary's entry into heaven. In Irish, it is called Lá Fhéile Naomh Muire san Fhómhar, that is, "The Feast Day of Our Lady in the Harvest Time". This theme is expressed in the liturgy of the day. Eastern theology has tended to focus on the dormition or "going to sleep" of the mother of God..

A feast on 15th August: the Dormition of the Theotokos: Although the New Testament does not make any reference to the last days of her life, celebrations of Mary's death, called her "Going to sleep" (Greek koimesis/ Latindormitio), began to appear from the 4th to the 6th centuries. From the 6th century, the Great Feast of the Dormition of the Theotokos was celebrated on 15th August throughout the Byzantine Empire, probably beginning from Jerusalem where there was, and still is, a church called the Tomb of Mary.

In the West, the Roman sacramentaries (Gelasian and Gregorian) have prayers for Masses for the Dormition of Our Lady for the same day, indicating that the feast was celebrated in Rome during the 7th century.

However, the spiritualities of East and West took a somewhat different focus. Eastern spirituality had no doubt that Mary died, that Jesus resurrected her on the third day and then brought her to heaven. Later Roman Catholic piety tended to the opinion that, since death is a consequence of sin, it would have been more fitting, in the case of Our Lady, that her freedom from original sin and from personal sin would have protected her from the general law of death (argumentum ex congruential or suitability, fittingness).
