

Remembering The Deceased November Dead Lists Throughout the month of November, the Church traditionally remembers and prays for all those who have died. A November Dead List is a list of the names of deceased relatives and friends for whom you would like Mass offered during November. Like all acts of remembrance, compiling a November Dead List is an act of charity to the faithful departed from those who are still able to assist them. The sheets on which to compile the list and accompanying envelopes are in the Church Porches. A voluntary offering may be included for the support of the priests who will celebrate the Masses. Return the envelope either in the collection basket or in the box in the Sanctuary. The list of the deceased will be placed in the Sanctuary where they will remain for the Month of November. Mass will be offered each day specifically for all those named on the lists, that they may attain what they long for, eternal rest in God's presence.

Christmas cards in aid of St Vincent de Paul will be on sale this weekend in both Mater Dei and St Joseph's Churches. A pack of 10 Cards costs £3 or 4 packs for £10. All money raised goes directly to St Vincent de Paul to help people in need in our Parish area.
