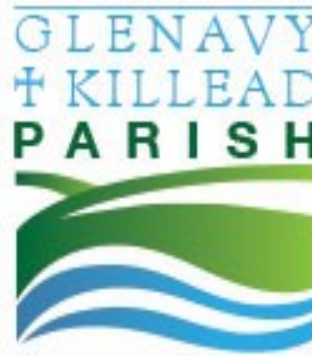

Stages of Patrick's Life

There were three major stages or turning points of Patrick's life, each of which was marked by a great personal crisis. The first stage began when, at the age of 16, his boyhood was brought to an abrupt end at the hand of kidnappers, who captured him and sold him into slavery 'along with many thousand others' (Confession, 1). This stage lasted for six years. Patrick responding to the divine call, finally escaped and made his way home. He was the first Roman citizen that we know of to ever succeed in escaping from captivity and live to tell the tale.




The second stage followed his decision to respond to the call of God and return to Ireland as a missionary. It included his ordination first as a priest and later as a bishop. During this time one of his fledging communities suffered an attack by Pictish pirates. Many men were put to the sword and many women carried off into slavery, and worse. This atrocity occasioned the Letter to Coroticus, which also included an extended defence of Patrick's episcopal authority. We are reminded of the Second Letter of St Paul to the Corinthians, written by Paul in order to defend his episcopal authority in the face of a rebellious community.

Finally, we come to the third stage, which included the revelation of the sins of his boyhood, his trial by a tribunal of his seniors, his conviction, and, finally, temporary removal from office. Patrick would not have been human if he had not been shaken to the core by these events.
