### **Celebrating the Presentation of the Lord**

The Feast of the Presentation is rich in liturgical action and opportunities for personal devotion. Over the centuries it has marked the triumph of Christ conquering the darkness, at the time of the year where days grow longer, and the weather begins to get warmer. Before electricity its significance was more tangible, but the themes of light, promise, commitment and hope fit beautifully into modern life and especially in this jubilee Year where we are asked to reflect on being Pilgrims of Hope.

The Presentation occurs 40 days after Christmas and brings festive season to a close. The earliest record of its observance is the 4<sup>th</sup> Century; Egeria writes about attending the liturgy in Jerusalem and clearly considers it a significant celebration; 'On the fortieth day after Epiphany. everyone gathers and things are done with the same solemnity as the feast of Easter.'

Also known as Candlemas Day, it originated in the Eastern church and known as 'The Encounter' recalling Simeon and Anna, representative of the Old Testament, meeting the Lord, symbol of the New. Pope Sergius 1 added it to the Roman calendar in the 7<sup>th</sup> Century.

Before 1969, February 2<sup>nd</sup> was known as The Feast of the Purification of Our Lady. As part of Mosaic law, Mary went to the temple to be cleansed after giving birth and to offer her son to God. By this presentation Jesus fulfilled the New Covenant; 'I am sending my messenger to prepare the way before me; and suddenly there will come to the temple the Lord who you seek.' (Mal 3:1) Though our thoughts are drawn towards Mary, it is always Christ who is at the centre of our prayers.
